Pre-Entries close April 15th to avoid \$30 late fee, per entrant

Credit Cards & Checks will only be accepted for pre-entries (checks must postmarked by April 15th or they will not be accepted)

Cash or Credit Cards will only be accepted for late entries, NO CHECKS

BY ENTERING YOU AGREE TO ABIDE BY AND FOLLOW ALL RULES.

*****New for 2025*****

Single weekend payouts, enter Friday, enter Saturday, or enter both days!

Progressive Minimum \$5000 Added in the Open 5D for the weekend (both days combined) and then progressive after each additional 100 entries.

- \$7,500 added with 400 entries in the Open 5D
- \$10,000 added with 500 entries in the Open 5D
- 75% payout

DRESS CODE:

- Cowboy hat or helmet, long-sleeved shirt, pants and boots are required.

Entries:

- Entries will be taken exclusively on [Saddlebook](#)
Credit card payments will incur a 4.5% credit card processing fee
- Checks will be accepted until April 15th:
 - Checks received with a postmark date beyond April 15th will not be accepted;
 - Entries paid by check with a postmark beyond April 15th must be immediately paid via credit card or entry will be canceled.
- Entries received after April 15th will incur a \$30 late fee:
 - Only credit card payments will be accepted on Saddlebook after April 15th
 - On-site entries with credit card or cash only will be accepted
 - Checks will not be accepted if postmarked after April 15th

- Returned NSF check fine is \$50

Late Entries:

- Will be accepted via [Saddlebook](#) up to the last 20 runs both days.
- Late entries after April 15th are subject to a \$30 late fee.
- If pre entered and enter another horse or class after books close you will incur a late fee.
- One late fee per rider, max.

Draws: Draws will consist of combined classes. (Open 5D, Youth, Junior)

- Draw #1 will include all entries & all classes submitted and paid by May 5th at midnight that did not select the "late draw" option in Saddlebook. Draw #1 will be posted May 7th by 9:00 am on Saddlebook and will exclude entries marked as "late draw".
- Draw #2 will include all entries & all classes from May 6th -May 8th at midnight that did not select "late draw" option in Saddlebook. Draw #2 will be posted by May 9th at 9:00 am on Saddlebook.
- The First Late draw will be done an hour before race start each day.
- Additional late draws will be done during the event as needed.

*****NEW*****With the exception of the Saturday Sweepstakes runs, the Friday and Saturday performances 1 & 2 draw order will combine randomly the Open 5D, Youth and Junior entries. Preferences in respect to buddying with another rider or the need to be put up in a specific drag i.e.: *before the 1st big drag, 2nd big drag, etc may be noted in the comments when entering to support those traveling to other events.*

Refunds:

- Draw outs will require a vet/medical release by May 10th, no later than the conclusion of the event.
- If a vet out is needed weekend of race, see the vet on site to get a vet slip.
- **VET/MEDICAL SLIPS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AFTER MAY 10TH.**
- No refunds will be issued without a vet/medical slip. Draw outs for reasons outside of documented vet/medical reasons will receive no refund.
- Refunds will be mailed after completion of the event with a vet/medical release received by May 10th.
- Horse substitution is allowable and must notify the office in person with the registered name of the substitute horse prior to competing. If this is not done the run will be an automatic disqualification and fees forfeited.
- 75% refunds on entry fee ONLY.
- No refund on credit card, Saddlebook processing fee or late fees.
- 100% refund on Stalls and RVs with advance email notification to turnnurnbarrelracing@gmail.com.
- Prior notice as stated above must be given. No shows will not be refunded. Cannot "sell" RV or stalls to another party.

Multiple riders:

- Horses cannot be run by multiple riders in the same day.
- Same horse/rider combination may only run once per day.

Min \$5,000 Added Progressive Open 5D:

- 5D Format with 0.5, 1, 1.5 & 2 second splits.
- 75% payback.
- Course measurements will be posted at the office.
- Perf #2 on Saturday, May 10 will run draw numbers 1-200. After rider 200, we will stop and prepare ground for 2D Sweepstakes, then resume Perf #2 after the conclusion of the sweepstakes
- The start time of the Saturday Sweepstakes will be posted May 7th
- Start time of draw 201-conclusion will be posted May 7th

\$1250 Added Youth:

- 4D Format
- 75% payback
- Riders must be 10 years of age or under as of January 1, 2025

\$1250 Added Junior:

- 4D Format
- 75% payback
- Riders must be 11-17 years of age as of January 1, 2025

Sweepstakes:

- Must have at least one Open 5D entry to be eligible for Sweepstakes entry
- \$200 entry fee
- 80 % payback
- 2D payout with 0.75 split
- Any Friday Perf 1 Sweepstakes entries will carry from Open, Youth or Junior
- Saturday Perf 2 Sweepstakes entries may either carry from Open, Youth or Junior into Sweepstakes or run in the Sweepstakes Showcase with designated start time after rider 200.
- The Sweepstakes Showcase will run after rider 200 in Perf #2 on Saturday, May 10. Specific start time for the Sweepstakes Showcase will be updated on the www.turnnburnbarrelracing.com schedule after the May 7th draw, and physically posted at the office during the race weekend when you check in.

Awards:

- Awards will be given in Open 5D, Sweepstakes, Junior & Youth classes:
 - Must be present or notify the office with name of person who will be accepting award(s) on your behalf
 - Must be in dress code. Awards photos are taken for sponsors
 - Awards will not be mailed

Stalls:

- Reserve Stalls via [Saddlebook](#)
- Stalls are required for \$35 per night.
 - You must declare if you are stalling a stallion
- Stalls are fully refundable with prior notice given to turnnburnbarrelracing@gmail.com.
 - Stalls cannot be resold to another person
 - For stall refunds, please contact Emily at turnnburnbarrelracing@gmail.com
 - Prior notice is required for refunds on stalls. No shows will not be refunded
- No overnight tying to trailers or self-penning, per the facility.
- If you are arriving late, you must purchase stalls in advance of arrival.
 - Unless reserved and paid for, stalls will be locked
- For stall and RV assistance, please contact Emily at turnnburnbarrelracing@gmail.com or call 541-350-9861.

Shavings:

- No outside shavings, per facility.
- Stalls will include 1 bag of shavings.
- Additional bags can be pre purchased and will be available onsite for \$10 per bag.

Parking/Camping:

- Reserve RV space via [Saddlebook](#).
- RV hook ups are \$35 per night.
- RVs are fully refundable.
 - RVs cannot be resold to another person
 - For RV refunds, please contact Emily at turnnburnbarrelracing@gmail.com
 - Prior notice is required for refunds on stalls. No shows will not be refunded
- RV spaces are limited and are on a first paid, first served basis.
- Dry camping is FREE. Dry camping is prohibited in RV and Spider Box designated areas. Vehicles parked in RV or Spider Box designated areas that do not have a reservation will be towed at owner's expense, without notice.
- Once RV spots are sold out, we will set up Spider Box (power only) reservations.
 - Spider Boxes will NOT support A/C units without blowing breakers. *We will contact you to ask you if you want to proceed with the reservation or obtain a refund, if you choose to proceed you must adhere to the A/C rules, per the facility.*
- PAID RV signs will be given upon check in at the office. These are required to be placed visibly in your vehicle or trailer window throughout the event.

Payouts:

- Checks will be mailed the following week of the event upon receipt of completed W9.
 - Checks will not be mailed until a current year W9 has been received
- Any balances owed will result in payoff checks being held until paid in full.
- Please be sure your correct mailing address is in Saddlebook when entering:
 - Checks will be issued to the address listed in [Saddlebook](#).

Short Stirrups:

- Ages 10 & under as of January 1st, 2025.
- Limited to 15 riders.
- **This is a lead line or walk, trot type rider class.**
- Guaranteed awards only, no payout.
- Short Stirrups cannot cross enter into Youth, Open or Sweepstakes.

SIDE POTS

These side pots are a carryover only and are available both days
Side pots are a combined Friday and Saturday single payout excluding Daily Dinero
Daily Dinero will be paid out daily

Senior side pot:

- \$40 Entry Fee
- Rider age 45 and over as of January 1, 2025.
- 4D payout with ½ second splits.
- 75% payback.
- Must carry from Open.

Your Barrel Connection (YBC) side pot:

- \$40 Entry Fee
- 4D option with ½ second splits.
- 70% payback (required by YBC rules)
- www.bestofbarrelonly.com
- Must carry from Youth, Junior or Open

Lucky #7 side pot:

- \$55 Entry Fee
- 3D format with 0.7 sec splits off fastest side pot 1D time.
- 75% payback
- Must carry from Youth, Junior or Open

Daily Dinero side pot:

- \$125 Entry Fee per day, 75% payout, with 1/2 second splits
- 4D Payout-50 entries or less, 5D payout 51 or more entries per day
- Must carry from Youth, Junior or Open
- Separate daily payout each day

Northwest Barrel Incentive Fund (NWBIF) side pot:

- \$40 Entry Fee
- 70% payback (required by NWBIF rules)
- 4D format with ½ second splits
- Must carry from Youth, Junior or Open

OBRA Open, 3500 Novice & 500 Novice Side pot

- \$40 Entry Fee
- 75% Payout
- Must carry from Open

Group Rides:

- Exhibitions will be in a Group Riding format.
- 15 min. intervals with maximum 5 riders available, per time slot. Same rider during 15 min group ride time.
- \$20 per time slot.
- If time slots fill, we will have a Group Riding waitlist on Saddlebook.
 - If a Group Ride becomes available, we will contact you with the time(s) available.
- No refunds on Group Rides unless the office is able to fill your spot. Group Rides cannot be resold to another person.
- If you don't need your time slot prior to the event weekend **notify the office at turnnurnbarrelracing@gmail.com**. Notification must be made in-person, at the office once event weekend has started. If we are able to find someone to fill your spot a refund will be given.
- For day of group rides, please check with gate person for availability and purchase.
- Turn N Burn Barrel Racing LLC reserves the right to add additional Group Riding slots at their discretion.

No Time:

- Contestants will receive a no time for knocking a barrel over or breaking the pattern.

Timers:

- An electric timer will be used.
- Reruns will be given only in the event of a timer malfunction.
- If a rerun is given, the contestant will choose from three options, and they must notify staff with rerun choice immediately.
 - Option 1: running the next available spot that matches draw position;
 - Option 2: run in late draw, keeping original draw position;
 - Option 3: opt out, receive refund on entry fee for that run only. If carrying over to any side pots, refund would be issued for those as well. Excluding processing, late and credit card fees.

Drags:

- There will be a tractor drag after every 5 drawn runs.
- Big drag after every 50 drawn.
- Turn outs and releases will be included in the draw.
- The ground may be reworked at any time at the discretion of The Valor H committee for the safety of riders and horses.

Disqualification:

- Contestants must be ready when called. Failure to be ready when called will result in disqualification.
- Announcer will call rider name three times, failure to be ready after 3rd call will result in disqualification.
- If a horse runs out of order, it will be disqualified.
- If you are parked in a RV or Spider Box hookup without reservation your vehicle will be towed at your expense and your entry fees forfeited.
- Horse switches must be approved in advance and in person at the office prior to the competition run being made. Un-notified horse changes will result in disqualification.

Concessions:

- The Rim Rock Café will be open Friday and Saturday for your convenience.

Non-registered vendors:

- Will be charged double the regular vendor fee and disqualified without refunds if competing at the event.
- Providing any goods or services onsite is considered vending and is not allowed without registration.
 - **No exceptions**
 - This is to provide equity to the paying vendors supporting our race

Dogs:

- Dogs must be on a leash at all times, per facility.
- No dogs in the arena or on the mezzanine.
- Dogs creating conflict, excessive barking, or safety concerns may be asked to be contained at trailer or removed from premises.

Per the facility, Parking Lot manure must be put in manure pile and not left in the parking lot, please. A facility wheel barrow is available for use if needed, please return it where you found it. Please pick up after yourself and show respect to the facility and others. Thank you
